All listings are first English language U.S. except where noted by {U.K.}. In these cases the first or only publication was in the United Kingdom. All entries include the publication year, the title of the book, the publisher, the byline under which Faust published the book, and alternate titles where there has been a title change or alternate editions where there has been a byline change or a more recent U.S. edition (for books originally first published in the United Kingdom). When a serial or compilation has been substantially abridged, this is noted, as is also the case with a story rewritten by someone other than Faust.

Original magazine serial publications on which a book is wholly or partially based appear in brackets []. Included are: the original title (in some short story collections if the story title was changed for book reprint it is noted as a reprint title followed by the original magazine title), the publication in which it appeared, the format (i.e. short story, serial, poem, etc.), the dates of the publication, and the byline under which the magazine work originally appeared.
